Information regarding donating to HopesCloset.

They are taking donations but do limit what is accepted. They do not have the resources or storage for donations unless there are items that they need/can use right away. This changes frequently, sometimes daily, depending on inventory. Please check with them on what is currently needed.

As of April 2023, the highest need for clothing is for children, especially girls, size 7 to 16 and teens small/medium (adult sizes are ok if they are teen appropriate). They also need casual shoes for all ages, from child to adult.

Adult business attire or dressier clothing is not needed currently, as most of clients are not working or are working from home.

Below is additional information regarding donating to HopesCloset.

They ask that all donations be:

- Clean (they have no way to wash anything)
- Current fashions



- Seasonally appropriate
- Free of stains and rips
- No visible wear and tear
- Shoes must have good tread
- Will also take new items
- New toys

Other items needed are: sheets (sets only), blankets, cleaning supplies and personal hygiene products (shampoo and other hair products, feminine hygiene products, lotion, body wash, diapers, etc.).

We **cannot** take anything that has been stored for any length of time.

We do not take pillows, knick-knacks, household goods, home décor, or small appliances, used toys and stuffed animals, we just do not have room to store them.
